11+ Exam 2020 The 11 plus exam for 2020 entrance to secondary school will be held on Saturday 14th September 2019. Registration will open on Monday 1st May and will close at 5pm on 26th June 2019. Parents must register their child when they are in Year 5 during the above registration dates on the link redbridge.gov.uk/schools/redbridge-11-plus/

Request for Leave of Absence during Term Time Pupils attend school for a maximum 190 days each academic year. Full attendance is Vital for your child's educational progress. The school regards absence as a very serious concern and it is a proven fact that there is a clear link between poor attendance at school and lower academic achievement (Department for Education (DfE, 2012). The DfE (2013) state that leave of absence requests for holidays should not be granted. The school will only grant leave in term time and in the most exceptional circumstances for which evidence will be requested. Request for leave during term time must be applied for in advance. Leave taken without permission of the Head Teacher will be recorded as unauthorised and you will be liable to pay a Penalty fine of £120 per parent, per child (£60 per parent, per child if within 21 days). The fines will be issued by Redbridge Education Welfare Service.

Get Involved with Neuroscience A research group in the department of Speech, Hearing and Phonetic Sciences at UCL, are studying the ways that children understand language and use mental effort to help in difficult listening situations. Children aged between 5 and 11 years are invited to take part in this study. If your child takes part they will be asked to complete some short intelligence and language tests and also listen to and make decisions about recordings of English sentences. Whilst they do so EEG (Electroencephalography) will be used to measure the child's brain activity via electric signals from their skin- this method is completely safe. The session lasts no longer than 90 minutes and each child that takes part will receive a small gift and be reimbursed for

any travel expenses. Sessions are carried out at a centre near Kings Cross station. If you would like to find out more or would be interested in having your child participate in this study, please contact Luke Martin on 0207 679 4247.
