Learning to Play a Musical Instrument

This is probably due to a number of factors, including the discipline of practice and perseverance that learning an instrument develops, increased confidence and also right-left brain co-ordination.

Would your child like to learn an instrument? There are spaces available for instrument tuition from Sept 2021. Lessons take place at Glade, weekly, during the school day.


Well Done Ruth and Sahib!




Attendance
