1. Keep writing your name. We would really like to see how you are getting on with writing your name. Please see if you can write your name on your own, I know you can! Can you use your toys to make all the letters in your name?
2. Have a go at writing the letters- m, d, g, o, c and k. You could use the letter formation sheets to trace over the letters and then try writing your own or write them in your blue book.
3. Can you think of five things that make the 'h' sound? Have a look around your house or in books to help you. Have a go at drawing what you find. You could even have a go at writing the words.
4. In our Zoom session you listened to the rhyming story 'Bug in a rug'. Can you find another story that has rhyming words? Ask your adult to read the story to you and listen out for the words that rhyme. Tell the adult what the rhyming words are.
5. Continue to read lots of different books. Can you find a story about someone going on an adventure? Follow the 'Reading document' on the Nursery page for reading ideas. You could watch this video to help you begin to read short words.
